REGULATIONS

(To be read in conjunction with the General Regulations of the Lilydale A & H Society Inc.)

1. Exhibitors must attach a tag showing name and address to the wrappings used.
2. Fleeces which in the opinion of the judge are overgrown or insufficiently skirted will be judged accordingly.
3. The Judge may transfer any fleece to the class in which it rightfully belongs.
4. The Judge may combine or split classes.
5. All fleeces are to be shorn from sheep which are the bona fide property of the exhibitor.
6. Exhibits will remain on display until 5.00pm on Sunday 17th November 2024.
7. The Most Successful Exhibitor in Sections G.a. and G.b. is awarded on the basis of:
1st – 3 points
2nd – 2 points
3rd – 1 point.

Where points are equal between exhibitors, a count back will be made of the highest number of 1st, 2nd or 3rd prizes to decide the award.

The Champion Merino and Crossbred Fleeces from the 2025 Lilydale Show will be entered into the District Fleece Competition at the 2026 Melbourne Royal Show.

These two fleeces will join others from the Central and Upper Goulburn District to compete with winning fleeces from kindred Victorian show societies.

The district winners will receive a sash presented by the Royal Agricultural Society of Victoria.

The fleeces in this competition shall become the property of the RASV, and after their exhibition will be sold and the proceeds donated to Legacy.

LAMB'S FLEECES – SECTION G.c.

Champion Lamb's Fleece: Trophy & Sash

Fleece must be the first shearing from a lamb or weaner with a lamb's tip, and may be of any length.

Fleece must be well skirted and will be judged on style.

White and **Coloured** lamb's fleeces will be judged separately, and each have a Champion.

FLEECE FROM A PET SHEEP OR LAMB – SECTION G.d.

Best Fleece from a Pet Sheep or Lamb: Trophy & Sash

Exhibitors and their pet sheep may be any age.

Please include the sheep's name and a photograph of the sheep and owner with the entry form - to be displayed with the fleece.
